ADMISSION

CRITERIA & RULES

A. Admission to all undergraduate (UG) programmes

1. Admissions to the First Year with subjects Chemistry, Microbiology, Computer Science and BCA programmes are merit based and for this, a student has to go through the college registration process. While admissions to other First Year B.Sc. subjects, First Year B.A., and First Year B.Com programmes will be based on First-come-First Serve basis and by direct admission procedure without any registration and merit list.
2. The college releases a notification regarding UG/PG admission in local newspapers as well as on notice boards of college and on college website.
3. Students should submit duly filled application forms along with the required documentary evidence to the college, before the due date.
4. In case of courses whose admissions are merit based, the college authorities will scrutinize the applications and prepare a merit list based on the marks obtained by the students and will display them on the notice board of college and on college website. If selected, the candidate has to pay the required fee and report to the Head of respective departments immediately.
5. While preparing the merit list, the College follows the reservation norms of the State Government of Maharashtra/ Government of India. College and the admission Committee ensures transparency in the entire admission process.
6. Admission to any courses offered by college is granted on the basis of the information furnished by the candidate in the application form. If the same is found to be wrong/ inadequate/ false, his or her admission will be liable to be canceled.
7. All admissions are subject to the eligibility criteria of Pratap College, Amalner (Autonomous) as well as Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. Students coming from other universities should submit a migration certificate to the university. Application for admission will not be considered unless it is,
 - Properly and correctly filled in, and signed by the candidate seeking the admission.
 - Accompanied by attested copies of the requisite certificates in support of the claims

made in the application.

- Received by the office on or before the last date of submission.

8. Details of Fees for the relevant academic session is shown in 'FEE STRUCTURE' in an updated prospectus provided by college along with the admission form. Students should note that No reminder for fees shall be sent
 9. Fees/Charges/deposits are subject to revision from time to time and Parents may expect a Fee hike roughly related to the rise in the cost-of-living index.
 10. For all other information, college provide an updated prospectus along with the admission form which gives detailed information on the vision and mission of the college, details of recognition and approvals from the various statutory authorities (National and International bodies), courses offered, with details of duration of the course, course pattern entry requirement, eligibility details, details of fees (fee structure) for the relevant academic session, ATKT rules for the admissions to 2nd and 3rd year B.Sc., B.A., B.Com and BCA, job opportunity, mode of selection, collaborative arrangements with other colleges and Universities, details of research programs etc.
 11. All the students applying individually should be made aware of the terms of student admissions policy and procedures by the admission committee of the college.
 12. College has the right to cancel any programme onto which students have been accepted, in accordance with its rules and regulations.

B. Admissions to all postgraduate courses

1. There is no entrance examination for any of the P.G. Courses conducted by the college. But in future entrance examinations for certain subjects of the P.G. Courses can be conducted by the college and it will be informed in due time on the website.
2. Admission for M.Sc. (Inorganic Chemistry, Organic Chemistry, Microbiology, Physics, Mathematics, Statistics, Computer Science, Botany, Zoology), M.A./M.Sc. (Geography), M.Com is merit based and for this, a student has to go through the college registration process. While admission for all M.A. (Marathi, Hindi, English, History, Political Science and Economics) courses will be based on First-come-First Serve basis and by direct admission procedure without any registration and merit list.
3. The college releases a notification regarding UG/PG admission in local newspapers as well as on notice boards of college and on college website.
4. Students should submit duly filled application forms along with the required documentary evidence to the college, before the due date.
5. In case of courses whose admissions are merit based, the college authorities will scrutinize the applications and prepare a merit list based on the marks obtained by the students and will display them on the notice board of the college and on the college

website. If selected, the candidate has to pay the required fee and report to the Head of respective departments immediately.
